Did you know that the act of tithing can be a thermometer of the spiritual life? An important study, conducted in five Adventist conferences around the world, revealed that the act of tithing is correlated to five other practices that connect a person to God:

- \* Daily Bible study
- \* Daily time for prayer
- \* Opening and closing the Sabbath
- \* Regular study of the Sabbath School lesson
- \* Presence at the Sabbath School class.

If any of those practices is missing, including the act of tithing, it may indicate that a spiritual disconnection is in process, increasing the risk of apostasy!

By the way, one of the first signs that someone no longer trusts God and His word, is that that person stops tithing! It is as if the God they worship would be so weak that if they would obey His voice by tithing, He would be unable to take care of them!

And this happens because in order to tithe, one must first trust that there is a God in heaven, that His word is still bidding, and that, as the Provider, He has control over the events of life, being able to do far more than what we ask or think.
